The initial appointment may be for a period of up to two (2) academic years. We seek applicants with the expertise to teach undergraduate courses in mechanics, and analysis and design of structures. Candidates must hold a master's or Ph.D. degree in Civil, Mechanical, Aerospace, or Structural Engineering, or a related field, and must have demonstrated evidence of effective teaching.

To apply, submit the following materials:

- A cover letter stating the term(s), course(s) and number of courses you are applying to teach.
- Curriculum vitae.
- A statement that describes prior teaching experience, provides evidence of effective teaching, and makes clear which courses the applicant is qualified to teach. Providing student evaluations in this statement or as a separate submission is strongly encouraged.
- A separate statement describing any teaching strategies you currently use or plan to use to foster a diverse and inclusive learning experience, and to enable all students to excel and fully participate in the learning process.
- A list of at least 2 references who can speak about the applicant's teaching experience and/or content knowledge.
